Assisted Compliance Audits

ACAPMA provides the Assisted Compliance Audits, an industry specific auditing services developed to allow fuel businesses to identify compliance requirements and receive professional advice, support and customised resources to address compliance gaps, resulting in a strengthened ability to demonstrate compliance to external parties.

The Audits focus on in-depth analysis of employment compliance.

The Audits are industry led and voluntary and as such there are no penalties issued for non-compliance areas identified, rather the process is a confidential undertaking where ACAPMA, as an employer organisation, provides participants with information, assistance and customised resources required to close any compliance gaps identified and achieve and demonstrate compliance in the future.

Audit Operation

On receipt of an application ACAPMA will issue an invoice and then contact the business with a questionnaire that will allow for the audit to be tailored to the businesses operations.

Once the questionnaire is processed and the Audit customised, ACAPMA will reach out to the business request for information and documentation to be provided within the 2 week deadline.

ACAPMA then reviews the documents and identifies any compliance gaps and creates the Gap Analysis and Resources for the business. This remote desktop audit is followed by the Audit Meeting, a teleconference that explores the gaps and the resources and recommendations and allows for rectification documents to be submitted for reassessment by a Rectification Date (usually 2 weeks).

The Audit is closed at the Rectification Date and a Certificate of Participation.

Extentions are available to all deadlines on request, however, it is important to note that failure to meet deadlines without an extention will result in the Audit being closed and a Fail Due To Non Participation Certificate being issued.

Outcomes of the Assisted Compliance Audit

After the Review and Rectification period, the Audit Participation Certificate is provided to the site. This document indicates the participation of the site in the program and identifies only the compliance gaps that remain open at the end of the audit process.

For example:

If a gap is identified as part of the audit, and is closed by the site through the use of resources provided and the resubmission of documents to ACAPMA, then the gap is considered closed and no gap is recorded on the Audit Participation Certificate.



Cost of Audit

Due to the extensive instruction that is provided by ACAPMA to each business, the Audit is only offered to ACAPMA Members.

Audit (Full scope)

The Full Fuel Retail Assisted Compliance Audit is available to Members as a stand alone item for **\$435 inc GST per site**.

Audit (limited Employment only scope)

The limited (Employment Scope Only) Fuel Retail Assisted Compliance Audit is available to Members as a stand alone item for **\$395 inc GST per site**.

Audit and Training Compliance Bundle

Members can choose to access the Audit and Training Bundle for **\$990 inc GST per site**.

This Bundle delivers access to the Fuel Retail Assisted Compliance Audit (full or employment only) for a site and access for that site to the Petroleum Convenience Compliance (PCC) online training course for all staff at that site for 12 months.

The PCC is an in depth, rich interactive online course that covers the standard compliance elements that are the same at all sites, ensuring that site staff know how to keep themselves and the business safe and compliant and that operators have the training and outcome evidence to show inspectors they are meeting their safety and training legislative obligations.

The PCC retails at a cost of \$335 inc GST per person for one off individual access or \$1,650 inc GST per site for annual site access.

The Audit and Training Bundle is the most cost effective way for a site to have the confidence that their staff are trained and their systems are able to demonstrate compliance, delivering a saving of more than \$1,100 per site.

Confidentiality, Privacy and Data Collection

The information collected as part of the Audit process may be subject to Privacy Laws. All such information will be collected, used, stored and destroyed as per the ACAPMA Privacy Policy. All personal information will be held confidential at all times.

ACAPMA will not provide the detailed Gap Report or Certificate to any person, other than at the direction of the business being audited.

ACAPMA will not disclose any compliance gaps identified to any person, other than at the direction of the business being audited.

ACAPMA does collect aggregated data on compliance issues across the industry, all site, business and personal information are removed prior to such aggregation.

ACAPMA may provide Audit Status Reporting showing that the audit is in one of the following status; NOT Activated, Active, In Resubmit or Closed.
